



In response to your telephone call of October 17, 1973, this will confirm that Larry E. Nunes and Richard Lee, also known as, Rick Lee, pleaded "Guilty" upon January 11, 1973, in this Court to violation of 182 of the Penal Code, the complaint alleging that said defendants did unlawfully conspire, combine, confederate and agree to commit the crime of keeping a house of ill-fame, a violation of Penal Code Section 315. In addition, Mr. Nunes pleaded "Guilty" to violation of 182, conspiracy to pervert and obstruct justice and the due administration of law. These defendants were thereupon placed by this Court upon three (3) years supervised probation subject to the payment of a fine of \$1,250.00.

## Three plead guilty in prostitution case

Three South County men today pleaded guilty to misdemeanor charges of conspiracy to establish a house of prostitution and to commit acts injurious to public health and morals.

Two of the men also pleaded guilty in Morro Bay Justice Court to misdemeanor charges of conspiracy to obstruct justice.

The trio had been charged with felony violations but Assistant District Attorney James Lindholm said the charges were reduced "in the interest of justice."

Justice Court Judge Fred Schenk could sentence them to a maximum of one year in jail and fine them \$1,000 for each charge. Sentencing is scheduled

for Feb. 2 at 1:30 p.m.

The three are Jack L. Pitts, 33, a former Pismo Beach reserve police officer; Larry E. Nunes, 34, who resigned in November as Fourth Judicial District constable, and Richard D. Lee, 40, an Arroyo Grande barber.

They were arrested Sept. 22 on felony charges of attempting to procure persons for prostitution and conspiracy to procure persons for prostitution. Nunes and Pitts also were charged with conspiracy to obstruct justice.

They waived a preliminary hearing and after several Superior Court appearances pleaded guilty to lesser charges. In return, District Attorney Robert Tait said he would make no recommendation for sentence.

This stipulated agreement was rejected by Superior Court Judge James A. Madden, who remanded the case back to Morro Bay Justice Court.

Today's guilty pleas were not entered under such an agreement.

Judge Schenk accepted the guilty pleas to the misdemeanor charges and said "this is a proper step to serve justice."

Lindholm said the publicity the case has attracted probably precludes finding an impartial jury in San Luis Obispo County. He added the case did not warrant the expense of a trial out of the county.

Lindholm said the men were charged under penal code sections which can be prosecuted either as felonies or misdemeanors.

I am not quite sure who to communicate with relative to volunteers who should no longer be associated with scouting but I have three volunteers who by virtue of their recent brushes with the law I feel should not be in the scouting program any longer. I would appreciate receiving a proper notification form for such matters.

For the record however, one is Larry E. Nunes, 34 years of age, resident of Arroyo Grande, California who was a member of our council executive board. Another was a Richard D. Lee, 40 years of age also of Arroyo Grande who was a neighborhood commissioner. Both of these men were arrested on charges of attempting to procure persons for prostitution. They have been charged with a misdemeanor and let off with heavy fines.

The other man is a Martin Snidow also of Arroyo Grande, 29 years of age, a former professional scouter with the Los Angeles Area Council who was taken into custody on the 22nd of August by the police department for cultivation and sale of marijuana and dangerous drugs.
