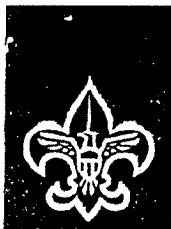


Dear John:


DISPOSITION OF CASE ON ROBERT JOHNS

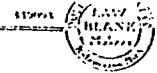

 2 religious background. I think it is very prevalent in the  
 3 probation report. I believe that should be taken into con-  
 4 sideration, because I think he is very sincere in his wishes  
 5 to rehabilitate himself and once again become a useful tool  
 6 in our society.

 8 He has advised me that he does  
 9 have some ambition. He shouldn't have gotten himself in a  
 10 very difficult problem, but he recognizes that problem. It  
 11 seems to me he would like the opportunity to cope with it,  
 12 and if he is sentenced to incarceration, that there be a  
 13 recommendation that he receive some kind of counseling and  
 14 some kind of therapy to deal with the problem.

THE COURT: Mr. Johns, your

23 prior criminal record indicates that in 1975 you were con-  
 24 victed of contributing to the delinquency of a minor. You  
 25 were convicted of a second offense in Tennessee known as a

1 crime against nature. You were sentenced on that charge.  
2 You are wanted by the State of Tennessee right now on a  
3 charge of sexual assault, sodomy, and your conviction in  
4 this Court is for the crime of criminal sexual conduct in  
5 the first degree, also including sodomy on a minor male  
6 child. This did not occur once, but multiple times with  
7 the threat of great bodily harm or death to the child, the  
8 victim, and children are particularly defenseless in our  
9 society.  
10

11 You are not only an adult,  
12 but a rather large adult male. I can imagine the mental  
13 and physical suffering that must have been endured by a  
14 twelve-year-old boy. You are a threat certainly to the  
15 children of the community. You have had a conviction for  
16 a similar crime like this in the past. You have voluntarily  
17 got into a job with the Boy Scouts of America which would  
18 only apparently get you into more trouble, which, in fact,  
19 it has. This certifies that this is a  
true copy of the original.

21 Deputy County Clerk You are not a good probation  
22 risk. It is the sentence and judgment of this Court that  
23 you be placed with the Michigan Department of Corrections  
24 located at the Southern Prison for Michigan at Jackson,  
25 Michigan. There you are to serve a maximum term which was

1 previously agreed to by this Court of fifteen years, and  
 2 a minimum term of ten years. You are to be given credit  
 3 for one hundred fifty-eight days which you have been in the  
 4 County Jail, and the Court does recommend psychological  
 5 counseling for you at this institution.

6 Mr. Johns, you are hereby  
 7 advised that you have a constitutional right of appeal of  
 8 your conviction to the Court of Appeals. If you intend to  
 9 appeal, you must file your appeal within sixty days of this  
 10 date.  
 11

12 You are also advised that you  
 13 are entitled to the services of an attorney to assist in  
 14 your appeal. If you are financially unable to provide your  
 15 own lawyer to perfect your appeal, the Court will appoint  
 16 a lawyer for you at public expense and will furnish the  
 17 lawyer such portions of the trial transcript as he requires  
 18 for post conviction proceedings and to perfect your appeal.

20 You are further advised that  
 21 your application for the appointment of counsel to assist  
 22 you must be submitted to this Court within sixty days of  
 23 this date.
