Hull Man Found Guilty Of Indecent Assault

A 33-year-old Hull man was found guilty of a second offense of indecent assault and battery on a child under 14 in a closed session Monday in Brockton Superior Court.

The defendant David A. Smith, 32, of 28 Barnstable St., was adjudged guilty by Judge Joseph S. Mitchell, Jr., after a jury waived trial, prosecuted by assistant district attorney Bruce P. Gilmore.

Judge Mitchell then continued the case to Oct. 29 for sentencing, and ordered psychiatric consultation for Smith so that the data would be available for the court's evaluation in sentencing.

Second offense indecent assault and battery carries a mandatory jail sentence and a possible maximum life sentence.

Last June Smith was acquitted on a similar charge by a jury. In that case Smith's attorney Barry Gerstein of Boston was granted a motion allowing him to have the words "second offense" stricken from the indictment read to the jury as "prejudicial."

Smith's first conviction on indecent assault and battery dates back to an offense in Brockton in 1964.

The closed session yesterday involved a five-year-old Hull girl.

Psychiatric treatment was ordered for a 34-year-old Kingston man charged with committing unnatural acts on several teenage boys.

The man James W. Eldridge of 35 Maple St. pleaded guilty to four counts of committing unnatural acts, and was given six months in the House of Correc-

tion suspended with two years probation. One of the stipulations of the probation ordered by Judge Mitchell is intensive psychiatric therapy.

The acts were committed in Eldridge's home over a two week period in January of this year.

A Brockton man, now serving time at Walpole State Prison, pleaded guilty to indecent assault and battery on a young Brockton girl in July of 1973, and was given additional time to serve.

Henry Shelby, 33, of 9 Crowell St. was given one year to be served from and after the sentence he is presently serving.

Frank Maher, 21, of 29 M St., Hull pleaded guilty to the unlawful possession of heroin with intent to distribute in Hull on Nov. 13, 1973.

He was given two years suspended and two years probation.

He also received similar sentences to run concurrently on charges of unlawful possession of a hypodermic needle, and receiving stolen property.

Daniel M. Redman, 23, of 80 A St., Hull was given a one year suspended sentence, three years probation, and ordered to enter project Turnabout after he pleaded guilty to breaking and entering in the nighttime.

Other charges against him including possession of burglarious tools, malicious injury to personal property, attempted larceny of a motor vehicle, receiving stolen property, and unlawful possession of a controlled substance, were filed.
