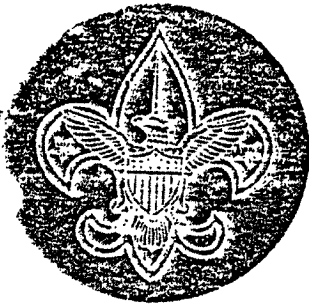

The enclosed letter was forwarded to me by Scout Executive Palmer Vance of the Shawnee Council in Lima, Ohio, as a result of my phoning him for information. This is in regards to Mr. John Johnston, former professional, which I called you about 2 weeks ago. As you indicated, if he had been in profession it would have been over 10 years ago. It was about 12 years ago.

We were alerted to a potential morals problem with John Johnston as a result of neighborhood gossip from the parents of boys who lived in his neighborhood.

[Redacted] told me he has another letter from the Police Chief of Wapakoneta, Ohio indicating that Mr. Johnston would be subject to arrest if he returned there.

At a hearing held in our Juvenile Court on January 12, 1970, a seventeen year old youth was interrogated about his unnatural sex acts with one John R. Johnston, Jr., a former Post Advisor of Explorer Post 164 in Wapakoneta, Ohio.

After a lengthy interrogation and a threat of a lie detector test this boy admitted to sexual perversion acts upon his person when he was approximately eleven years of age and continuing for some four years. This youth denied any activity during the past year even though he was living with John R. Johnston, Jr. in Minnesota in December, 1969. Mr. Johnston requested the boy to submit but he refused.
