JUDGMENT AND SENTENCE


Now on this 14th day of August, 19 81, Defendant ROD REMINGTON appears in open court in person and with his attorney WALTER WALKER. The Court, ~~having considered the evidence~~ ~~for a new trial~~, informs Defendant he has been ~~tried by a jury~~ and found guilty of the crime of SODOMY and asks him if he has any legal cause to show why judgment should not be pronounced against him. Defendant fails to show cause. The Court fixes sentence (in accordance with the verdict or under the provisions of ~~the Second Offender Act~~) at 10 years, in the Missouri Department of Corrections at Jefferson City, Missouri.

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED BY THE COURT that Defendant ROD REMINGTON, having been found guilty of SODOMY, be committed to the custody of the Department of Corrections of the State of Missouri for a period of TEN (10) years ~~XXXXXX~~ ~~XXXXXX~~, to be confined in the manner prescribed by law until the sentence and judgment of this Court be complied with or until Defendant shall otherwise be discharged by due process of law. **Defendant given credit for 2 days jail time spent in the Newton County, Missouri jail.**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the State have and recover from Defendant the costs of this prosecution and that execution be issued therefor.
