Scout Leader Gets DD For Molesting Boys

WIESBADEN — Boy Scout leader Sgt Larry W. Wood liked kids.

But his fondness for youngsters, a 17th AF general court ruled last week, was perverted. The jury convicted the married airman of committing homosexual acts with three Scouts aged 11 to 13.

Slender, sandy-haired Wood, a 23-year-old electrician with the 497th Recon Tec Gp, faced a possible 21 years in prison as he pleaded innocent to three counts of taking indecent liberties with minors.

The incidents last January, the

Boys swore in court, occurred in the Scout building in Crestview housing area. The first involved a 13-year-old whom Wood asked to remain with him following a first-aid class, then sexually molested.

Next night, after lights-out as a number of boys bunked overnight in the Scout building, Wood committed unnatural acts upon two 11-year-olds.

Wood, whose wife was living in Biloxi, Miss., declined to testify at his trial. The nine-officer tribunal sentenced him to three years behind bars and ended his five-year Air Force career with a dishonorable discharge.

Charged with violation of Uniform Code of Military Justice- Article 134.

SPECIFICATION # 1 - In that Sgt. Larry Wood- 497th RTG-APO 09633-Wiesbaden Germany did, at Wiesbaden, Bierstadt, Germany, on or about 14 January 1968 take indecent liberties with [REDACTED], a male -16 years of age, by massaging [REDACTED] penis and by placing [REDACTED] hand on his (Wood's) penis with intent to gratify the sexual desires of the said Larry Wood.

SPECIFICATION # 2- Reads the same as above except- [REDACTED] ---, by massaging [REDACTED] penis, having [REDACTED] message Wood's penis and then placing his (Wood's) penis between [REDACTED] legs with intent to gratify thr sexual desires of said Larry Wood.

Sgt. Wood applied for discharge under appropriate regulations (for the good of the service)

His organization recommended disapproval of his application.

Charges have been drawn up for the trial by Courts Martial and the Article 32 investigation completed.

At this writing- additional charges are being promulgated, Wood is due to go on trial the week of 18 March 1968.

Additional information in regard to this case will be sent as soon as the Courts Martial convenes.


Dear Jerry

As you requested, here are the facts as I know them concerning the incident of 14 January 1968 involving SERGEANT (E-4) LARRY W. WOOD, AF 13 748 020, 497th RTG, APO 09633 (Assistant Scoutmaster Troop 224, Wiesbaden, Germany and Acting Scoutmaster Troop 459, Kastel Housing).

At approximately 0800 hours, 14 January 1968, Scout [REDACTED], DOB 11 Feb 56, the son of Staff Sergeant [REDACTED] AF 17 403 678, 2063 Comm Sq, APO 09633 (Kastel Apts, F 6) returned from spending the night with Troop 459 at the Scout Headquarters Building, 3 Marsweg, Crestview Housing, Wiesbaden, Germany, and reported to his father that Sergeant Wood had fondled his penis. Sergeant [REDACTED] reported the incident to the Air Police and it is presently under investigation by the OSI. I understand that another allegation has been made by a [REDACTED] of the same troop and that the OSI may have other reported incidents.

According to Scout [REDACTED], Sergeant Wood entered the room where he was sleeping in his sleeping bag on the floor with several other scouts and placed his sleeping bag next to [REDACTED] bag. Sergeant Wood massaged [REDACTED] stomach, [REDACTED] dozed off and awoke to find Wood massaging his penis. Wood took [REDACTED] hand and attempted to have [REDACTED] massage Wood's penis, but [REDACTED] rolled over away from Wood and Wood then left the room. The incident allegedly occurred sometime between 0400 and 0600 hours on 14 January. Sergeant Wood and between 6 and 10 scouts of Troop 224 were spending the night in the building in connection with a clean up detail. Several members of Troop 11 and their Scoutmaster Virgil Smith were also spending the night in the building in connection with painting their area of the building.
