
Do we have an adverse record on the above mentioned individual in the personnel files?

Bill Dukelow just wrote us and his lead sentence was "Do we have an adverse record on the above mentioned individual in the personnel files?" This was in reference to Daniel J. Schweig, 2332 Harrison Street, Oakland, California.

We sure do! Mr. Schweig first came to our attention in November of 1964 from Washington, D. C.. He had formerly been active as Assistant Scoutmaster with Troop 560 in Manhattan, New York City.

Of course, I cannot give you specific information as to the nature of the reasons why we are unwilling to accept Mr. Schweig's registration. I hope you will be able to accept my statement that under no circumstances should this man be allowed to have any association with boys in the Scouting program, either officially or unofficially. The nature of our information concerning him is such that we will never again, knowingly, accept his registration in the Boy Scouts of America.

Please thank Bill Dukelow for bring this matter to our attention. His suspicions are entirely correct. Best personnel regards.

After careful consideration and investigation, we feel that the following man should not be registered with the Boy Scouts of America. A description of the man and a short summary of the reasons that prompted us to take this action appear below.

It has been brought to our attention by a reliable source of the police department that Mr. Schweig is a suspected sex pervert. While he has not been charged or convicted of any crime, he is a leading suspect in the Metropolitan area of any crime involving the sexual molesting of children. Therefore, we do not feel that he can be registered with the Boy Scouts of America.

He was formerly registered with the Manhattan Council in Troop 560, New York, New York. When we told Mr. Schweig that we could not register him, he became quite angry and stated that he was going to write the National office. I do not believe that he will, but I mention this so that you could alert the proper people regarding any correspondence of this nature.
