Man, 34, Is Convicted In Fondling Case Here

A 34-year-old former Westbrook scoutmaster has been convicted of fondling a 14-year-old girl.

A Cumberland County jury deliberated more than two hours late Thursday afternoon before convicting William B. Brown of 36 Westbrook Gardens of unlawful sexual contact, a misdemeanor.

The girl had told the jurors that the incident occurred in June 1976 when she and several of her friends stopped by Brown's home.

She said that when her friends and Brown's wife had left the living room, Brown, a reserve policeman, suggested she try on some handcuffs.

She said that she agreed, and while her hands were cuffed behind her back, he

pulled her on his lap and began fondling her.

Brown, who took the stand, denied that he was ever alone with the girl or that he had ever touched her.

He said that she had fallen onto his lap and only stayed there momentarily. He also denied that she was ever handcuffed.

His wife, who also testified, supported his story, saying she had never left the room while the girl was there.

His trial in Superior Court stemmed from his appeal of his conviction last December in Portland District Court.

Justice William E. McCarthy set Brown's sentencing for Oct. 21. The offense carries a maximum one year's jail sentence.





The troop he was Scoutmaster of - Troop 81 of St. Mary's Church in Westbrook, has reregistered and just did not reregister him. They have recruited a new Scoutmaster and are doing well. Mr. Brown still has the troop records he refuses to turn over but the Troop Committee has duplicated most of them and does not feel that any further action to regain their possession is worth the bother or expense. There is no money involved, just paper records and advancements.

Dear Mr. Ernst,

This letter is to inform you of the general nature of some allegations that are proposed for the dismissal of William B. Brown, Scoutmaster of Troop 81, St. Mary's Catholic Church, Westbrook, Maine.

The Troop Committee and sponsor have asked him to resign verbally and in writing via registered letter. In response Mr. Brown has stated that he does not recognize their authority and has refused verbally to resign and refuses to turn over the troop records. He has yet to answer the registered letter or turn over the troop records to the committee chairman as requested.

The reasons the committee gives for his dismissal are:

- Interference in another troop's operations regarding the standards and awarding of the Eagle Award, creating considerable ill will between troops and sponsors.
- At a recent Council Camporee in October he left his troop unattended, without the Scouts' knowledge, or the District Directors, to sleep in his car in the parking lot. The District leadership was unaware of his absence since the troop was well behaved. New Scouts became frightened the next morning (Sunday) when they discovered themselves alone. The troop committee has received parental complaints regarding his actions.
- At the same Camporee he arrived by entering through a blocked gate. He was stopped by an Explorer Traffic Control officer. Mr. Brown gave the boy a difficult time and entered any way. When he left that evening (the troop was then under the leadership of the Assistant Scoutmaster), he again left by the wrong gate. Two Explorers asked him to stop, which he did not do. He slowed down as he approached them, again giving them verbal abuse, and knocked over the barrier with his auto.

After the first incident, the Explorer came to the Camporee Chairman and informed him of the incident, and the description of the car. After the second incident, the two Explorers again came to the Camporee Chairman and gave him the description of the car, its driver, and the plate number.

Our "on duty deputy sheriff" ran a check on the car and confirmed it to be registered to William B. Brown of 93 Westbrook Gardens, westbrook, Maine - a car of the same description, make and model.

Mr. Brown has been very beligerent during this whole series of events. He will not recognize the authority of the Troop Committee, Institutional Representative, or Sponsor. He has intimidated them and impounded the troop records. (No money involved to our knowledge, or the troop committee's knowledge.)


The sponsor and committee have handled this situation exceedingly well. They have also recruited a new Scoutmaster to take Mr. Brown's place.

Failing to remove Mr. Brown, either verbally or in writing, they have requested the council, through its local Casco Bay District, to take action to remove him so they can continue their Scouting program under new leadership.

We are prepared to deliver the recommended letter to Mr. Brown upon your immediate approval of this situation, if you feel it warrants it.

We are aware of an alleged morals charge against him, although we have made no accusations regarding it. However, we feel, along with the troop committee, that sufficient cause to remove him does exist without the morals charge. He has been arraigned and a trial date has been set. The sponsor feels that it may become embarrassing if he is found guilty and is still registered as their Scoutmaster. The troop committee is now operating the troop meetings but Mr. Brown has attended the last few.
