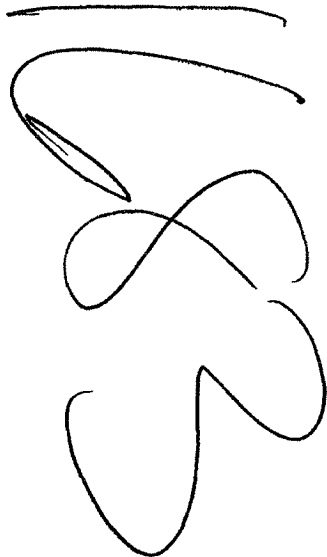

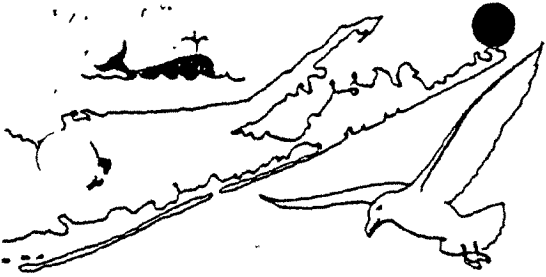

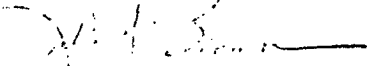
Dear Mr. Corringham:

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

Man Charged in Kidnap

Seaford—A security supervisor for a private guard service was released in \$5,000 bail Monday following his arraignment on a charge of kidnaping in connection with the alleged sexual molestation of a 16-year-old boy early New Year's Day. The accused is suspected of similarly kidnaping and molesting a 15-year-old Suffolk County boy in November, police said.

In the Nassau case, the suspect, Brian Corringham, 20, of 3 Liberty Lane, Plainview, is accused of abducting the boy about midnight New Year's eve from a street in Seaford while the boy was with another 16-year-old boy. According to police, Corringham jumped from a car wearing a ski mask and brandishing a shotgun and ordered the two boys to lie face-down on the ground. He then gagged and blindfolded one of the boys, put him in the back of his car and drove away, police said.

Corringham allegedly took the boy to the headquarters of his employer, Vna Security at 645 Commack Rd., Commack, where police said he made the boy remove all his clothes after forcing him to drink a quantity of whisky. Corringham then allegedly fondled the boy, cut hair from the boy's pubic area and questioned him closely on personal matters for about four hours. He then let the boy dress and drove him to Route 110 in Huntington, where he left him about 4:30 New Year's morning, police said.

Police said they traced Corringham because he wore his guard uniform bearing a triangular shoulder patch during both the New Year's Day and the November incidents. In addition, police said, one of the victims was able to see signs and other objects from under his blindfold. Both youths identified Corringham's voice, police said.

Corringham was arraigned in First District Court Monday before Judge Marvin Goodson who set bail for him in \$5,000 and in the custody of his father. Pottolke police said their investigation of the November incident has not been completed.
