This information will enable us to identify Mr. Cameron should he ever again attempt to register in the Scouting program. Thanks for your cooperation regarding this matter.

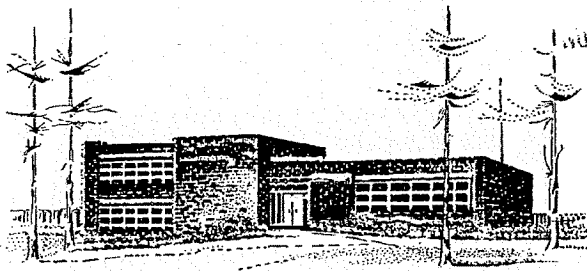


