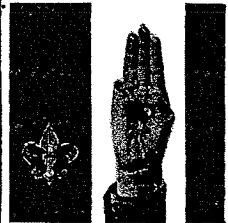

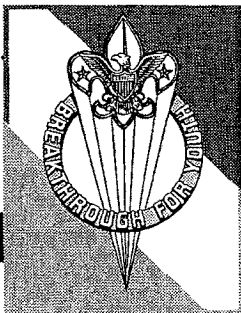

DSE Roach has resigned effective March 15, 1966 at the request of Scout Executive James L. Bartel, with recommendation that his name be placed in our professional confidential file.

On March 7, Roach reported to Bartel that he was involved with a Den Mother. Later the same day, Roach retracted this confession, then stating he was suffering unnatural attraction toward teenage boys.

Roach further said he didn't want to be camp director this summer for fear he might cause a scandal and hurt Scouting.

The only local persons apprised of this matter are William F. Dalzell, Council President, and two of the three remaining district executives, John Gower and Marion Combs.

Roach is expected to go to his parents home near Johnstown, Pennsylvania for psychiatric treatment.

All of the above information was reported to me by Scout Executive Bartel.
