This information will enable us to identify Mr. Aziz, should he ever again attempt to register in the Scouting program.

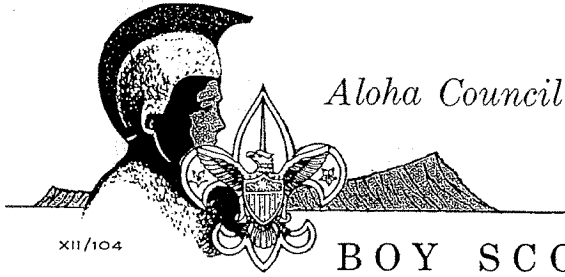

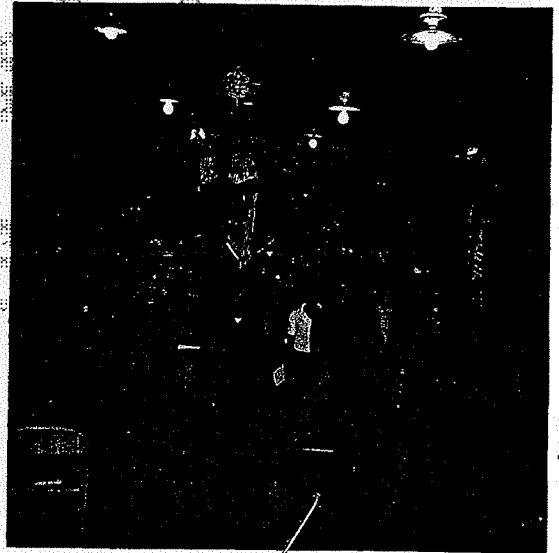
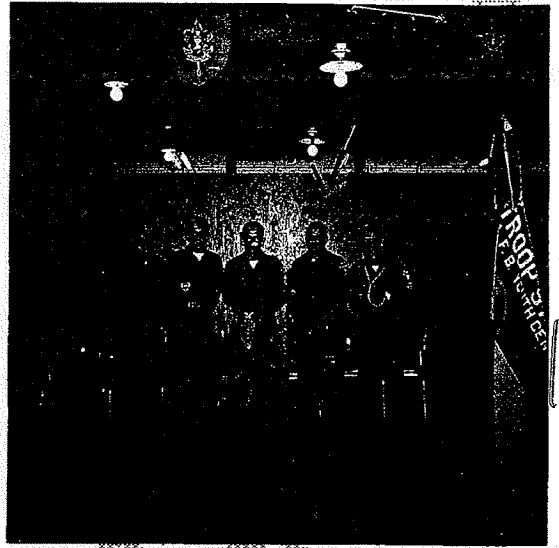

I realize that this was because of an incident with which I was concerned. Namely that which happened in Troop 97 of Hickham Air Force Base, Hawaii.

I was given an undesirable discharge from the service for this and after talking to a few Doctors I realized what I had done. I also realized how wrong it was and made effort to correct the situation.

Upon arriving how I talked to my family doctor and to other professionals about my problem and they and I feel that I have conquered this problem.

I have been in scouting for a long time and frankly it is the only pleasure that I get out of life. The fact the helping young boys find the right way to life instead of taking a wrong turn like I did helps me an awful lot. The fact that I am helping these boys grow up right and grow up to build a stronger America makes me feel very proud. Some day I hope to forget the ugly past and remember only the future.
