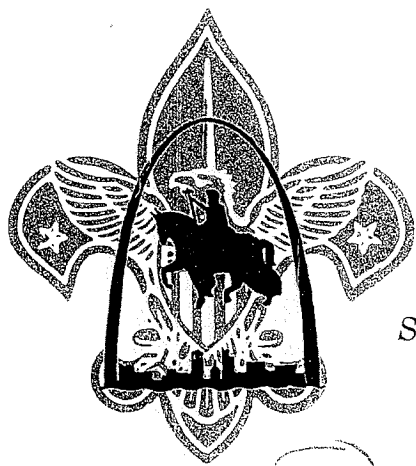

We respectfully request that Carl Henry Beckman III, 304 Honeysuckle Avenue, Webster Groves, Missouri 63119, date of birth 10/17/42, Assistant Scoutmaster, Troop 350, Suburban District, St. Louis Area Council be placed immediately on the Confidential File.

The Chairman of the Troop Committee of Troop 350 has already taken action.

Mr. Beckman was arrested on February 12 by Sgt. Braun and Patrolman Blair of the Webster Groves Police Department and has confessed to inducing youngsters into his car for immoral purposes. Mr. Beckman is now in the custody of the St. Louis County Psychiatric Department for examination. If he is found mentally disturbed he will be transferred to Fulton, Missouri Mental Hospital. If found otherwise, he will be prosecuted for inducing youngsters into his car.

Webster Man Charged With Enticing Child

Three warrants were issued Tuesday charging Carl Henry Beckman III, 20, of 304 Honeyuckle dr., Webster Groves with enticing a child.

Beckman was released on bond, set at a total of \$15,000 by Magistrate Leslie T. Lewis. The bonds are returnable March 4. The warrants were issued by Magistrate Lewis after Beckman was released from St. Louis County Hospital, where he underwent psychiatric examination.

Webster Groves police arrested Beckman, who admitted picking up a total of 16 children in seven St. Louis County municipalities, St. Louis and unincorporated parts of the county in the past two months.

The cases in which warrants were issued involve a 6-year-old boy and girl in Webster Groves on Feb. 6, an 8-year-old girl in Webster Groves on Dec. 12 and a 6-year-old boy in Kirkwood on Dec. 31. Beckman denied molesting any of the children he picked up, police said.
