No "official" information available from U.S.A.F. Received call from official of Base Hospital at Robins Air Force Base, Ga., stating the above named should not be permitted to serve in Scouting. Indicated perversion as well as psychiatric problem. Official confirmation was asked for but denied by military. Since this man has some 20 odd years of military service he will be retired rather than receive a dishonorable discharge. I was told his retirement certificate would indicate the reason for early retirement and information would be available to the National Council from the records of the FBI.

It is well known that this man attended many Troop meetings heavily under the influence of alcohol.

This man expressed interest in the professional service - turned down.

This additional information will enable us to complete our records and enable us to identify Messrs. Willis and Franklin should they ever again attempt to register in the Scouting program.

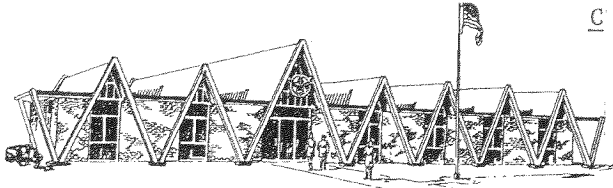

This man is out on \$4,000 bond awaiting action of the Grand Jury. He has 2 charges, thus far, of molesting a minor. He admitted to the District Executive serving the area that the charges are true. He is a Civil Service employee of Robins Air Force Base. The Base will review his case on August 23. His felony trial will not come up until later in the year provided the Grand Jury indicts.

CLAUDIE H. FRANKLIN Route #3, Joan Drive, Macon, Ga.
Former Scoutmaster, Troop 120, Warner Robins

Prompted by an "unofficial" call from the Base, Sgt. Franklin was replaced by the Troop Committee as Scoutmaster several months ago. He is a career man with more than enough time to retire from the service. We understand he is undergoing psychiatric treatment prior to his "retirement" from the Air Force. Our sources say that the type of separation certificate will be sufficient proof of his undesirability as a leader of boys. I gather that sources available to you will justify his being placed on our confidential list.

Please let me know if there is any other information necessary or if there is anything else I should do.
